Events of The Month

7th Muharram

Today is the day the camp of Imam Husayn (as) no longer had access to water.

Imam Husayn's (as) companion, Yazid bin Hussayn al Hamadani asked Imam for permission to persuade Umar ib Sa'd to allow them to bring water from the river. Upon seeing Umar ibn Sa'd, he did not greet him with "Salaam". Ibn Sa'd asked, "Why did you not greet me? Am I not a Muslim?" to which Al Hamadani replied, "You have assembled to kill the Prophet's grandson. With what excuse will you plead before the Prophet (saw) for whose intercession you hope on the Day of Judgement?

You have denied water to children that even an infidel will not do. How do you then call yourself a Muslim?"

Umar ibn Sa'd replied, he was not concerned about the day of Judgement, only of the Governorship of Ray.

17th Muharram - Abraha attacked Holy Kaabah 570

This event, well known to children and adults alike. It is inspiring to see how much faith and trust Abdul Muttalib (as) had in Allah (swt).

"The Owner of this House is its Defender, and I am sure He will save it from the attack of the adversaries and will not dishonour the servants of His House." was Abdul Muttalib's response to Abraha.

"Have you not seen how your Lord dealt with the companions of the Elephant? Did He not make their treacherous plan go astray? And He sent against them birds in flocks, striking them with stones of baked clay, so He rendered them like straw eaten up. (Qur'an, 105)

18th Muharram - Qibla changed from Bayt al Muqadas to Holy Kabah 2 AH

The Archangel Jibreel came when the Prophet had already performed two rak'ats of noon prayers and communicated to him the Divine command that he should then forward turn to Masjidul Haram.

In some of the narratives it has been said that the Archangel held the hand of the Prophet and turned him to Masjidul Haram. Men and women who were present in the mosque followed suit and from that day onwards the Ka'bah became the permanent qiblah of the Muslims.

It's a Miracle! The Prophet, while offering prayers, turned from Baytul Maqdis to the Ka'bah in such a way that there was not the least deviation from the direction of Ka'bah.
